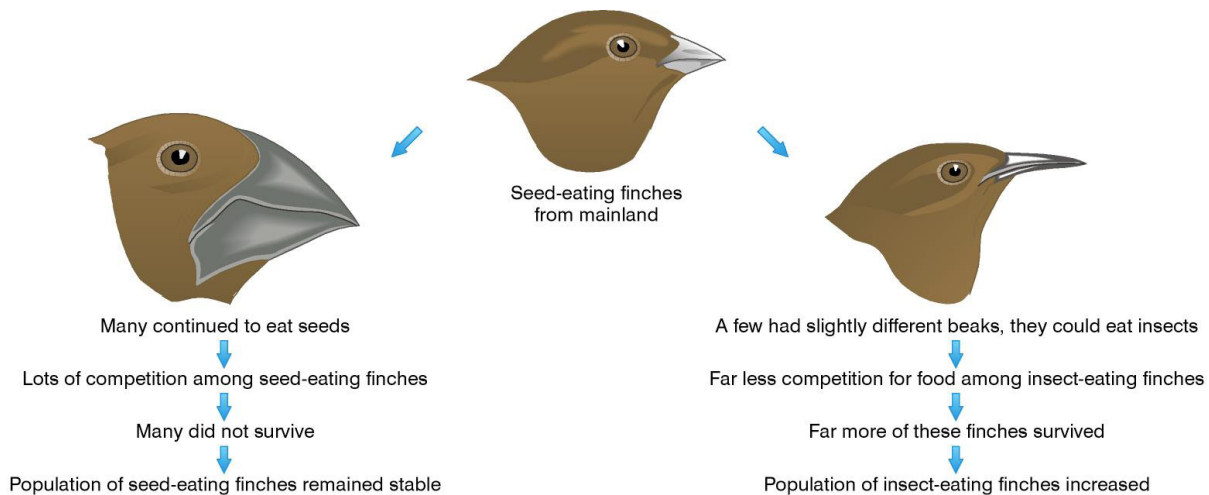


# Darwin's finches - Inquiry activity

Look at the diagrams below and use the information to think scientifically – just like Darwin



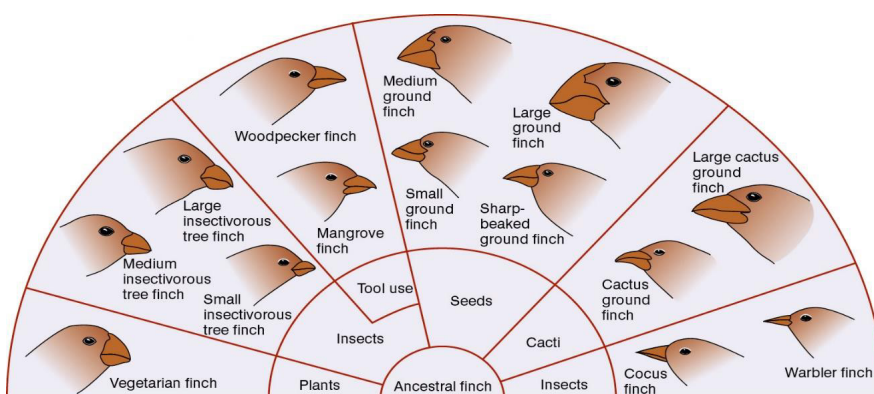
## Seed-eating finch
