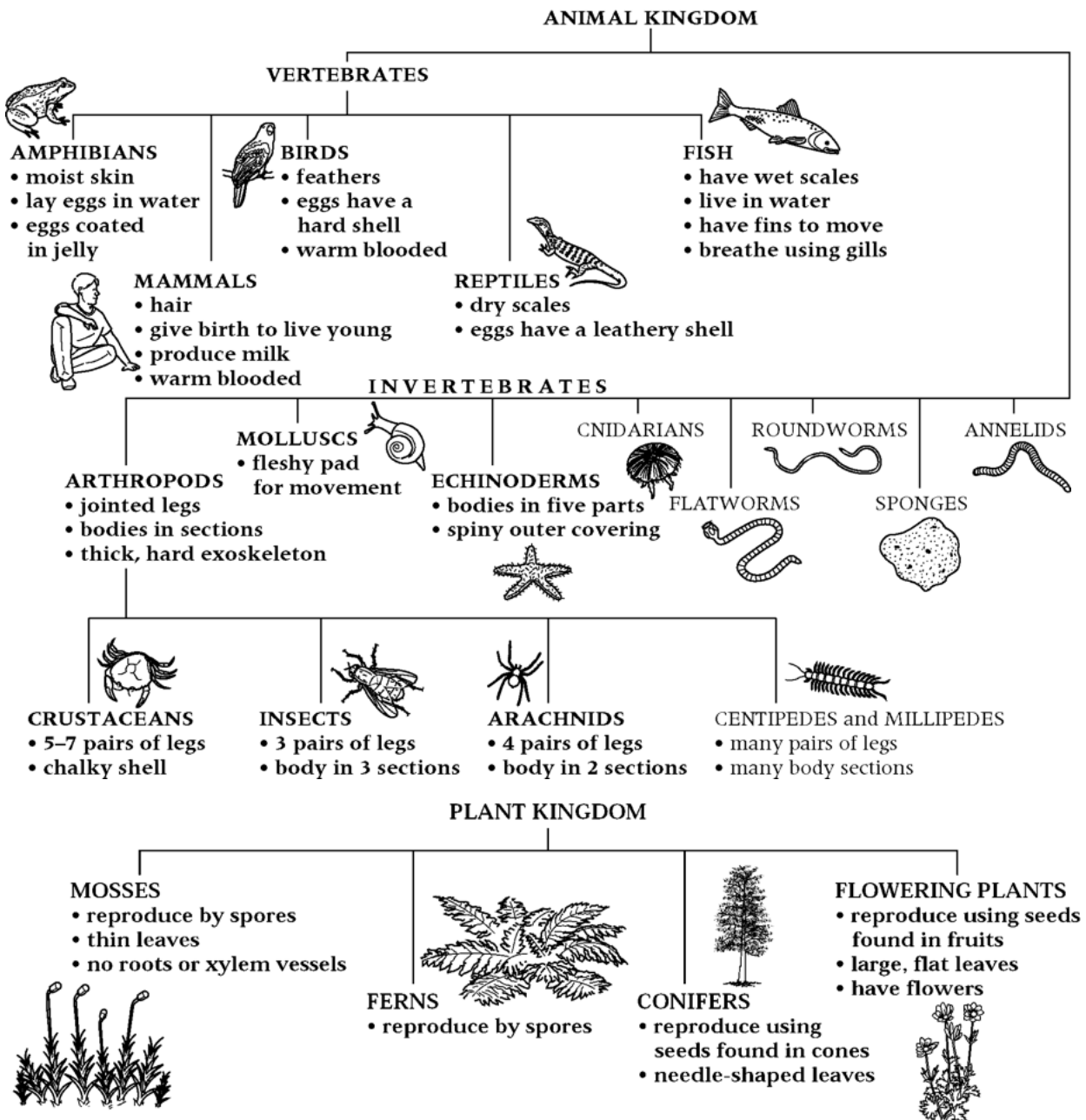


Sorting kingdoms - inquiry activity

- ③ Write the name of each animal or plant in your table and decide which groups it is in. Use the diagram above to help you. For example, an ant is an animal, an arthropod and an insect.
- ④ Write down the reason why you have put it in the smallest of these groups. For example, an ant is an insect because it has six jointed legs.
